2017 Women in Soccer Conference Registration FAQ's

How old must I be to register for the conference?

Participants must be at least 16 years old and anyone under 18 years old, must be accompanied by an adult if staying overnight.

If I am not involved in soccer can I attend your conference?

Absolutely – we would love to have you join us!

If I do not live in Alberta, can I attend your conference?

Absolutely – we would love to have you join us!

What does it cost to register for the conference?

There are registration options from \$75-\$250 depending on when you register, if you are attending for one day or two days and if you require accommodations.

What does the registration fee include?

What type of accommodations will be provided?

Rooms at Red Deer College are set up in pods. Each pod has 4 small bedrooms with a shared kitchen and bathrooms. Upon registration at the conference, if you selected that you required accommodation, you will be assigned a room in a pod. If you requested to share a 'pod' with others we will do our utmost to assign you to the same pod.

How do I register for the conference and make payment?

When will I know that payment has been processed and that I am registered?

100 Spots will be filled on a first-come (and paid) first-served basis. Once a registration has been processed you will receive a confirmation by email.

What should I do if I need to cancel my registration?

Refund and Cancellation requests must be received in writing.

- If received 10 + business days before May 5th = full refund less 15% administration fee.
- If received 9 – 0 business days prior to May 5th = full refund less 25% administration fee if vacant space can be filled by waitlist or if space cannot be filled, no refund.
