Notification of Acceptance:	January 5, 2018
Minimum Qualifications:	C License Trained (i.e. completed C License course and MED online evaluation)
Application Process:	Applicants need to email their applications to Carmen Charon at programs@albertasoccer.com . Ensure your application includes a cover letter noting your reason for applying to the program in addition to a soccer specific resume. Ensure your resume includes relevant education, playing background, coaching experience and other key sport training/experience(s).
Introduction to the Learning Facilitator Role:	February 9-11, 2018 (Red Deer) <i>This weekend will be focused on Coach Developer Training for Learning Facilitators. Specifically, core training and content specific training.</i>
Women in Soccer Conference:	April 14, 2018 (Calgary) or April 15, 2018 (Edmonton)
Learning Facilitator Co-Delivery:	April 7-8, 2018 or April 21-22, 2018 <i>Candidates must be available for at least one of these weekends to co-deliver a workshop with an experienced learning facilitator.</i>



Introduction to the Coach Evaluator Role:	May 4, 2018 & May 6, 2018 (Calgary), or May 11, 2018 & May 13, 2018 (Edmonton) <i>Candidates will complete core training for coach evaluators on Friday and observe live coach evaluations on Sunday. This is an introduction to the coach developer role of coach evaluator.</i>
C Licence Course:	May 26-27, 2018 & June 9-10, 2018 (Calgary), or June 2-3, 2018 & June 16-17, 2018. <i>Candidates must be available to attend at least one weekend of the C Licence course to gain insight into the competencies expected of C Licence coaches.</i>
Coach Evaluator Co-Evaluation:	September 10, 2018 (Calgary) or September 11, 2018 (Edmonton) <i>Candidates will be given an opportunity to work alongside an experienced coach evaluator to gain an understanding of the expectations of evaluators during a formal evaluation.</i>
Program Assessment (Year 1):	September 28, 2018 <i>Candidates will complete a formal reflection of the first year of the program and assist with setting up an action plan for year 2.</i>
