Mini Stars Outreach Days

Thank you for your interest in hosting a One-Day Mini Stars Program. Please read the hosting requirements and then complete the pre-event application details before submitting to the Manager of Grassroots Development at grassroots@albertasoccer.com

HOSTING REQUIREMENTS:

FACILITY

- An indoor playing surface suitable to host the anticipated number of players
- The facility should be available for 7 consecutive hours, including a lunch-break
- Washrooms for players
- Classroom for lunch and parent presentation
- Access to PowerPoint screen for the parent presentation
- Supply of size 4 soccer balls, pinnies, and cones

PERSONNEL

- Each program will support the training and inclusion of coaches who would like to work alongside the Mini Stars One-Day program.
- Coaches should be trained at NCCP Learning to Train or C License level.
- Coaches will be provided a curriculum and coaching t-shirt for the event.
- Coaches should attend in appropriate soccer attire and be available for the full day.
- A local administrator to be available to assist with any facility logistics and registration on the day.

PROGRAM ENROLMENT

- The host will agree to reimburse Alberta Soccer \$1,000 for the Mini Stars One-Day event (this cost can be offset by the income generated from the event).
- **The program fees will be set and retained by the hosting community.**
- All players and coaches will be required to enroll through the hosting community.
- Minimum number of player and coach enrolments will be required to be met two weeks prior to the event.
 - Minimum numbers: 12 players, with coaches assigned on a 1:12 ratio, so for 24 players the event will require 2 supporting coaches.
- Each player and coach will receive a Mini Stars t-shirt for the event.
- Alberta Soccer will develop promotional materials for this event.
