Payments will be made only by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT), and if you are not already set up for this you will be contacted by our accounting department when payments are scheduled.

Provincial Competitions – Assignment Process

Each year, various Alberta Soccer districts host outdoor and indoor provincial competitions requiring referee services. Invitations to officiate at Provincials are intended to reward those who consistently show strong performance, both on and off the field. The process is shown below.

6 to 8 weeks ahead

Referee in Chief nominated by hosting district to Alberta Soccer.

Any referees not being used are notified by Referee in Chief with as much notice as possible.

4 to 6 weeks ahead

Referee in Chief sends invitations to referees in their district.

Game assignments published no less than three days prior to opening day.

4 to 6 weeks ahead

Out of district referees are recruited by Alberta Soccer if needed.

Final day games may be pre-assigned or assigned during the competition.

2 to 3 weeks ahead

Alberta Soccer sends game schedule to Referee in Chief.

Game fees paid to referees by Alberta Soccer or District within 6 weeks of competition close.

Note – for Tier 1 youth competitions leading to Nationals and senior competitions leading to nationals, the Referee Development Committee Assignor will act as Referee in Chief.
