B. For each registered senior team, the fee shall be such cost above the CSA fee that is determined annually by voting delegates at the Annual General Meeting of the ASA.

C. For each registered youth team, the fee shall be such cost above the CSA fee that is determined annually by voting delegates at the Annual General Meeting of the ASA.

E. The ASA youth player registration fee will be paid per player as registered in the indoor season and per player as registered in the outdoor season. The ASA adult registration fee will be paid for each unique player per year. In as much as the basic player membership in the ASA/CSA is based on the outdoor season, if an indoor youth player was not registered for the previous outdoor season, the base ASA outdoor player registration fee must also be paid in addition to the player fee. Likewise, if a senior team was not registered for the previous outdoor season, the base outdoor senior team registration fee must also be paid in addition to the indoor player fee.

F. All youth outdoor membership registration numbers and indoor membership fees registration numbers paid by in a District on behalf of nonpreviously outdoor registered indoor players will be added together in calculating that Districts' votes for ASA General Meetings.

G. All senior unique membership registration numbers in a district will be used to calculate the Districts votes for the ASA General Meetings.
