Requirements

To qualify for the award, it is imperative that a nominee satisfactorily fulfills all stipulated requirements:

1. Good Standing: The nominee should be in good standing with the Alberta Soccer Association and its Members, both in terms of their conduct and any administrative requirements.
2. Longevity: 15 years or more of experience and contribution to soccer.

3. 10 years or more of experience and contribution to the technical development of athletes in Alberta.

4. Current members of the Board of Directors or past members of one year or less are not eligible for nomination.

Criteria

Consider the criteria not merely as prerequisites but as a strategic compass, directing nominees towards attributes valued by the Alberta Soccer Association. While meeting every criterion is not obligatory, it significantly amplifies the likelihood of selection.

1. Qualifications: The nominee should hold relevant coaching licenses or certifications, including advanced coaching credentials, which demonstrate their commitment to technical excellence.
