Requirements

2. 5 years or more of experience and contribution to officiating
Years of Experience:
3. Current members of the Board of Directors or past members of one year or less are not eligible for nomination.

Criteria

Consider the criteria not merely as prerequisites but as a strategic compass, directing nominees towards attributes valued by the Alberta Soccer Association. While meeting every criterion is not obligatory, it significantly amplifies the likelihood of selection.

1. **Dedication and Loyalty:** The nominee should have demonstrated unwavering dedication to the field of refereeing and shown loyalty to the principles of fair play and sportsmanship.
