Requirements

To qualify for the award, it is imperative that a nominee satisfactorily fulfills all stipulated requirements:

1. Good Standing: The nominee should be in good standing with the Alberta Soccer Association and its Members, both in terms of their conduct and any administrative requirements.
2. Minimum of 5 years of proving contribution to the development of soccer in Alberta.
Years of experience:
3. Current members of the Referee Development Committee or past members of one year or less are not eligible for nomination

Criteria

Consider the criteria not merely as prerequisites but as a strategic compass, directing nominees towards attributes valued by the Alberta Soccer Association. While meeting every criterion is not obligatory, it significantly amplifies the likelihood of selection.

1. Leadership and Impact: The recipient should be a woman who has demonstrated outstanding leadership and has made a significant and positive impact in the field of soccer.
