

Maintaining Upgrade Classification



Maintaining Referee Classification

This document pertains to registered and current officials in the <u>Regional</u> and <u>Provincial</u> classifications (Jan 1 to Dec 31, 2024)

Fitness:

- The High Intensity Test (ASA approved) must be completed within the year (Jan 1 to Dec 31) to maintain regional/provincial classification.
- If candidate is not successful completing fitness test at ASA approved event the official will be downgraded as of January 1 of the following year to the next lower classification (ex. Provincial to Regional, Regional to District).

Evaluation of Competency:

 All officials in Regional or Provincial classification are subject to evaluation (assessments) for minimum required competencies at any point throughout the year. This may affect maintaining classification if requirements are not met.



How to <u>return</u> to previous classification if downgraded:

- Within the year following downgrade (Jan 1 to Dec 31) The candidate is required to complete ASA approved fitness test at the appropriate classification required and complete *minimum one assessment* at an 8.3/8.4 grade or higher.
- Assessment(s) must be requested through the Referee
 Development Lead or ASA Assessor chair(s). Game level
 requirements must meet with approval from the Referee
 Development Lead and RDT for the required standards of
 classification.
- Upon completion, classification will be reinstated to the next highest classification, not exceeding the level in which the official has completed the upgrade requirements for.
