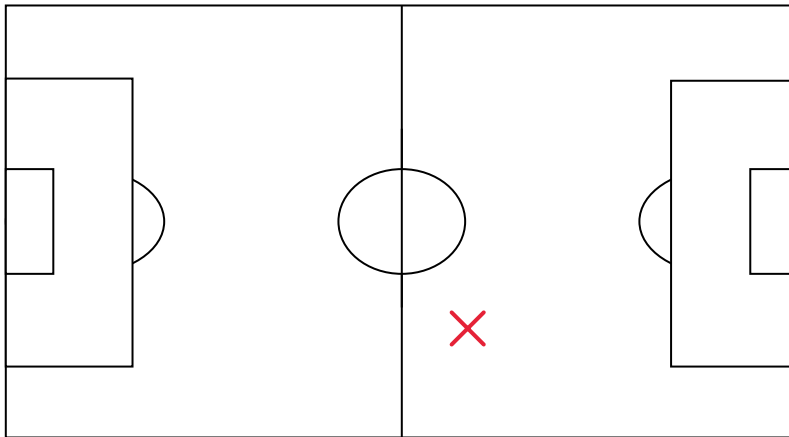
The incident occurred 73 minutes into the game and was as follows:
