The incident occurred 77 minutes into the game and was as follows:

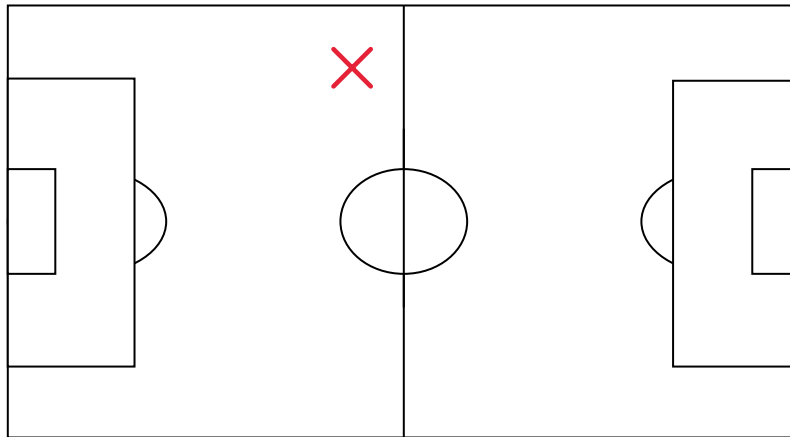
