

The incident occurred 43 minutes into the game and was as follows:

During play in the 43 minute of the game, #10 Anne Smith from the Lions, was fouled by a Tigers player in a careless challenge. I stopped play and signalled a free kick for the Lions. #10 Anne Smith from the Lions stood up and punched the Tigers player in the stomach in retaliation. I showed a red card for Violent Conduct to #10 Anne Smith from the Lions, who left the field without further issues. Play was restarted with a direct free kick to the Lions for the original offense.
